



## Siteman Investment Program 2018 Cycle 2 - Request for Applications (RFA)

### Purpose:

The Siteman Investment Program (SIP) funds internal, cancer-related research projects twice a year. This funding opportunity is designed to support projects which involve clinical trials, correlative studies on otherwise funded clinical trials, or which generate preliminary data that will provide the basis for future NIH or other nationally competitive funding. The 2018 Cycle 2 is open. For details, see the attached [RFA](#).

### 2018 Cycle 2 Updates:

To ensure all requirements are met, please review the 2018 Cycle 2 RFA thoroughly. Significant updates this cycle include (but are not limited to):

- The “pre-SPORE/PPG” program has been renamed the “Team Science” program to support the use of this mechanism as a precursor for all larger, team science-oriented NCI/NIH grants including: SPOREs, PPGs, and U54s.
- At the time of submission for a “Team Science” project, scientific teams and projects are expected to be well-established. In addition, it is expected that there will be significant progress in the administration and organization throughout the duration of the SIP award. As such, the release of year 2 funds will be contingent on meeting requirements during year 1 as outlined in the RFA.
- “Team Science” PIs are strongly encouraged to present all planned projects to SCC’s Senior Leadership Committee prior to submitting to SIP. Senior Leaders will assess readiness for funding and provide feedback to PIs. Details on scheduling this presentation are outlined in the RFA.

### Mechanisms:

-Pre-R01 for WUSM faculty: **up to \$200,000\* over 2 years**

-Pre-R01 for SLU Consortium faculty and WU Danforth Campus faculty: **up to \$200,000\* over 2 years**

-Multi-PI Pre-R01: **up to \$400,000\* over 2 years**

-Team Science: **up to \$800,000\* over 2 years**

\*please note: although applicants may request up to the full amount, there is no minimum amount required

### 2018 SIP Cycle 2 Deadlines:

Statement of Intent: September 4, 2018 by 4:00pm CST

Full Application: October 1, 2018 by 4:00pm CST

Decision Notification: December 15, 2018

Award Start Date: January 1, 2019
