

# Funding Opportunity: V Foundation Scholar Award

**Agency:** [V Foundation for Cancer Research](#)

**Mechanism:** V Foundation Scholar Award

**Overview:** The V Scholar Grant is a two-year grant of \$100,000 per year. It supports young tenure-track faculty early in their cancer research careers by funding projects that are either laboratory-based fundamental research or translational research.

**Internal Competition Deadline:** November 26, 2018

**Grant Amount and Term:** \$200,000 over 2 years

**Eligibility:** Applicant must be chosen by the Institution to apply (through the Internal Competition process). Candidate must have demonstrated expertise and promise in designated area of cancer research. Candidate must have completed at least two years of fellowship training, hold current tenured track faculty position, have joined faculty as instructor or assistant professor no more than five years ago. Candidates must not have R01 funding. But those with Institutional or K08 awards are eligible.
