The Cancer Research Institute is proud to announce the **Lloyd J. Old STAR Program** and is requesting applications for this new grant opportunity. The CRI Lloyd J. Old STAR Program—**Scientists TAKing Risks**—will provide long-term funding to mid-career scientists, providing them a degree of freedom and flexibility to pursue high-risk, high-reward research at the forefront of discovery and innovation.

These new grants will not be tied to a specific research project, but rather will support outstanding researchers based on the quality and promise of their overall work. A successful candidate is one that will demonstrate confidence and curiosity to ask difficult immunological questions—forging new understandings and innovation that will drive the field forward. Candidates selected for this award are expected to be future “stars” in the field of cancer immunology.

**Eligibility:** Candidates must hold a tenure-track faculty appointment as an assistant professor (minimum 3 years) or as an associate professor (maximum of 3 years).

**Application Deadline:** March 1, 2019

**Funding:** \$1.25 million over five years
