Amendment & Data Migration Deadline Changes

- All protocols and amendments approved in eSirius on July 12 will be automatically migrated to LAMPS.
- The last date to submit an amendment or new protocol remains July 12, but any submissions still pending on this date will not be migrated to LAMPS on July 29.
- For amendments pending on July 12, the unmodified version of the protocol will be available in LAMPS on July 29. IACUC will contact you when the amendment is approved.
- Any new protocol submissions pending on July 12 will not be available in LAMPS until September 2, meaning that no amendments can be submitted in LAMPS during this time. If an emergent need arises, contact [IACUC](#).
- eSirius will remain available through July 28, however, only those responding to IACUC requests should access the system after July 12. If you have a pending amendment or protocol as of July 12, IACUC will notify you how to continue with the review process.

Personnel & Edit Access

The PI of the protocol will be the only individual on the migrated LAMPS with edit access. All other personnel will be moved over with **view only** access.

To grant an individual edit access, the PI must login to LAMPS on or after July 29 and update the person's access by starting an amendment and editing the Personnel Information page. More information on this process will be available on go-live.

Approval Letters

Once eSirius protocols are migrated into LAMPS as [converted records](#), completed approval letters will not be automatically available within the system. See the Approval Letters section of the [What to Know when LAMPS goes live page](#) on how to generate a letter on or after July 29.
