It is effective in improving your relationship with both mentors and mentees.

Each mentorship training session lasts 3 hours and will meet July 23 and 24 from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. You must attend both sessions in order to receive a completion certificate. The interactive format consists of learning mentoring skills through case studies in small and large group discussions. Each session is led by a facilitator who has completed the [National Research Mentoring Network \(NRMN\)](#) implementation training.
