CDTR Pilot and Feasibility Studies Request for Applications

The Center for Diabetes Translation Research (CDTR) is soliciting applications for its Pilot and Feasibility Program. Projects must be for translation research, preferably T3 or T4; and in the area of diabetes, prediabetes/metabolic syndrome, or obesity prevention or treatment. T3 research is translating clinical findings into everyday practice in real world settings; T4 research explores testing and implementing solutions at a population level.

Applicants may apply for either of the following RFAs:

- One-year projects, up to \$25,000
- Six-month small projects, up to \$5,000

Letters of intent are due to allisonphad@wustl.edu by February 3, 2020. Full proposals are due April 1, 2020.
