The McDonnell International Scholars Academy is pleased to launch a new Global Incubator Seed Grants Fund. Our goal is to stimulate high-impact research projects in any discipline linking WashU faculty and international collaborators.

Proposals should include at least one international collaborator, with preference given to projects involving faculty from McDonnell Academy partner institutions (other institutions beyond that are welcome). Projects that involve collaborations in Africa and Latin America will be given additional preference.

Two types of seed grants are available to support faculty research initiatives responsive to this call. We anticipate funding up to 10 proposals at **\$10,000** each and up to 6 proposals at up to **\$25,000** each. Funding is for 1 year only.
